



Wenona Pool *COVIDSafe* Protocols

Rationale

This document outlines the COVIDSafe processes that have been implemented to ensure that the Wenona Pool remains COVIDSafe and adheres to government guidelines and regulations.

1. Conditions of Entry

No student, staff member, or visitor is to enter the facility if they are feeling unwell or displaying symptoms of COVID-19.

2. Visitors

Visitors may spectate the Main pool from the pool viewing deck on Level 2 and the LTS pool from the bleachers. These locations are indicated on the map attached.

3. Face Masks

All staff and visitors are encouraged to wear a well-fitting face mask/shield in the facility, especially when unable to socially distance.

4. Equipment

All students and/or staff must bring their own cap, goggles, towel, and water bottle to every session. Swim Squad swimmers must use equipment from their own kit bags i.e., flippers, kickboard, pull buoy, snorkel.

5. Hygiene

The facility is cleaned every night and a deep clean conducted once per week. The following hygiene protocols are also strongly encouraged:

- Sanitise hands upon entry and exit
- Practice physical distancing
- Use antibacterial wipes provided to wipe down any shared equipment after use
- Students and staff to bring their own water bottles and the bubbler should only be used to refill drink bottles.
- Changerooms will also be sanitised after lunch time, and a full clean at the end of every day.
