

## Hats off to our 2014 school leavers!

We congratulate all of Wenona's 2014 Year 12 students and our teachers for achieving impressive HSC results.



### Some 2014 HSC highlights

- **Caitlin Lee** (Dux) achieved first place in the State in History Extension and the highest possible ATAR, 99.95. She also ranked second in the state for Legal Studies and ninth for Modern History.
- **India Coultas** achieved an ATAR of 99.8 and ranked sixth in the State for Legal Studies.
- **Caillie Dunne** achieved Wenona's third highest ATAR, 99.4.
- **Lucy Tiley** ranked eighth in the State for Textiles and Design.
- **English:** In Advanced English, 36 per cent of students achieved a Band 6 result, while 36 per cent of students in English Extension 1 and 33 per cent of students in English Extension 2 achieved a mark in the top performance band (E4).
- **TAS:** 72 per cent of students achieved a Band 6 result in Textiles and Design.
- **Visual Arts:** 50 per cent of students received a Band 6 result and 100 per cent of students received marks in the top two performance bands.
- **History:** 40 per cent of students achieved a result in the top performance band (E4) for History Extension and 29 per cent of students achieved a Band 6 result in Modern History.
- **Social Sciences:** 35 per cent of Legal Studies, 33 per cent of Geography, and 29 per cent of Business Studies students achieved a Band 6 result.
- **Mathematics:** 96 per cent of Mathematics Extension 1 students, 64 per cent of Mathematics General 2 students, and nearly 60 per cent of Mathematics 2 Unit students achieved results in the top two performance bands.
- **Science:** 68 per cent of Chemistry students and 78 per cent of Earth and Environmental Science students achieved marks in the top two performance bands.
- **Drama:** 55 per cent of students received a Band 6 result and 100 per cent of students received marks in the top two performance bands.
- **Music:** 100 per cent of Music 1, Music 2 and Music Extension students performed in the top two bands.
- **Six Wenona students** were named on the Board of Studies, Teaching and Educational Standards (BOSTES) All Round Achievers List for attaining marks of 90 and above in at least 10 units. Details next page.
- **Wenona's Class of 2014** achieved 189 mentions on the Board of Studies Distinguished Achievers' List. There were 68 individual Wenona students who appeared on the Distinguished Achievers List.
- **Five students' major works and projects** were nominated for inclusion in BOSTES HSC showcases. *Details next page.*
