The highlights include:

- Jessica Ellis achieved Wenona's top ATAR of 99.8
- Two Wenona students, Jessica Ellis (Visual Arts) and Audrey Metcalfe (Dance), accomplished First Place in Course, each attaining a mark of 100%
- Overall, a remarkable 13 members of the cohort were recognised on the Top Achievers in Course list, which acknowledges students who attain state placings
- Eleven students were named on the All-round Achievers list, demonstrating excellence across at least 10 units of study
- The Distinguished Achievers list featured 138 Wenona students, who accomplished the highest band possible for one or more HSC courses
- Our students' creativity and diverse talents were recognised through six individual NESA Showcase selections and a record 55 individual nominations
