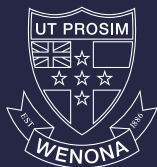

Today we congratulate the Class of 2025 on their Higher School Certificate results.

We are proud of the efforts of this cohort, whose achievements are a testament to their determination, ambition and resilience.

We thank their parents and families whose partnership and encouragement have been instrumental in ensuring these young women flourish. We also acknowledge the expertise and guidance provided by our staff throughout their Wenona journey,

and express gratitude to our extended community for their unwavering support.

The highlights include:

- Jessica Ellis achieved Wenona's top ATAR of 99.8
- Two Wenona students, Jessica Ellis (Visual Arts) and Audrey Metcalfe (Dance), accomplished First Place in Course, each attaining a mark of 100%
- Overall, a remarkable 13 members of the cohort were recognised on the Top Achievers in Course list, which acknowledges students who attain state placings
- Eleven students were named on the All-round Achievers list, demonstrating excellence across at least 10 units of study
- The Distinguished Achievers list featured 138 Wenona students, who accomplished the highest band possible for one or more HSC courses
- Our students' creativity and diverse talents were recognised through six individual NESA Showcase selections and a record 55 individual nominations

These are young women who have brought energy to every endeavour, from the sporting field to the stage and from community service to student leadership. ## Distinguished Achievers List

67% of students were mentioned on the Distinguished Achievers List, which recognises all students with a top band result for one or more HSC courses.
